

Provincial Small Claims Court

Orders of Seizure and Sale (up to \$35,000)

We require a deposit in the amount of \$500 which in most cases will cover the initial assessment costs. Initial assessment may include conducting vehicle and other asset searches as well as a field visit to the address provided for the debtor and any admin fees.

Fees:

- Statutory Fee \$80.00 (set by the Court)
- Hourly Rate \$60.00
- Mileage .50c/ km
- Fuel Disbursement calculated on a sliding scale. Currently calculated at .20 -.28 cents/km

Poundage on sum realized is assessed as follows:

• 10% Poundage

Below are listed some of the additional costs which will appear as disbursements on the invoice that might be incurred in the course of enforcing the Order. These fees, **when possible**, are collected from seizure of debtor(s) assets and/or voluntary payment by the debtor.
